



Parent Teacher Interviews **Book Now**


A reminder to all families that Parent/Child/Teacher Interviews will be held on THURSDAY, 20TH AUGUST.

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you and your family well. As you are well aware Covid-19 is having a huge impact on our day to day lives and this may be our 'new normal' for quite some time. St. Michael's acknowledges the pressure ongoing restrictions and remote learning is having on our students, families, ourselves and our own families.

Our number one priority is keeping each other safe and healthy, physically and emotionally. As a staff we agree it is essential to address the needs of all individuals within our community during this uncertain time.

As of next Wednesday St. Michael's will be introducing a "Wellbeing Wednesday." This is a day for our students and parents to stop and prioritise their own self care in a fun and engaging manner. The teachers will be introducing this day to the students in the days leading up to our first "Wellbeing Wednesday" on August, 19th. This special Wellbeing day will run until the end of term.

We have developed a Virtual Wellbeing Hub that your children can access during the day and on the hub you will find;

- Weekly Wellbeing challenges specifically designed to engage the students in non-screen based activities.
- A Virtual Wellbeing Hub filled with Covid-19 safety tips, opportunities to practise mindfulness, Google Games, Mojo Lessons and more.

As well as accessing the Virtual Wellbeing Hub your child will be invited to fill out a morning check-in once per week. It will be a quick and simple Google Form that will allow your child to check in with their teacher.

Please note, on this day your child is expected to attend their morning Zoom session only as no targeted teaching groups will be held on this day. If your child has been having a Zoom session with their teacher on Wednesday, this will be rescheduled on another day throughout the week.
